Who is WEA Member Benefits?

What happens if my work is selected?

If selected for display, we will provide a prepaid box for you to mail the original artwork to our office. If we are unable to display the original piece, we may request a high-resolution file for printing and framing. Selected artists will also be asked a few questions about themselves and how their artwork connects to the theme. Original artwork can be returned upon request; however, WEA Member Benefits is not responsible for any damage that may occur during shipping.

Where will the art be displayed?

All art will be on display at WEA Member Benefits in Madison, Wisconsin. The artwork may rotate between the lobby, meeting rooms, offices, and other locations throughout the building.
